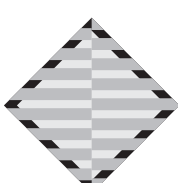
Q: **My teeth are starting to move and my dentist says I have periodontal disease with bone loss. I really want to save them. Will seeing a periodontist be enough?**

A: Seeing the periodontist is a great start, but a more comprehensive treatment plan is important in creating a longer-term more predictable result. Many of these more complex cases are also referred to the Prosthodontist who works as a team with your general dentist and periodontist, to help create the best plan. It's not just about treating the disease, but understanding the cause, correcting this and creating a plan to protect and prevent future breakdown. Adjusting the bite and stabilizing teeth with different splinting techniques can often enhance periodontal surgical results, especially if bone grafting procedures are needed to save teeth. Sometimes temporary splinted crowns and bridges are needed to help with this, often combined with selective extraction to aid in the prognosis of remaining teeth. Becoming excellent in your daily dental maintenance with brushing, flossing, and use of specific rinses or other therapeutic aids, can contribute greatly to improving the long term prognosis.
